

Climate Change

First. In Noah's day global climate change involved a mighty flood, not caused by man's carbon footprint but by his great wickedness. Genesis 6:5-7.

Second. In Israel's early history. God warned: " take heed to yourselves, lest your heart be deceived, and you turn aside and serve other gods and worship them, lest the Lord's anger be aroused against you' and shut up the heavens so that there be no rain, and the land yield no produce."
"Deuteronomy 11: 17."

Third, Later Israel's king , Ahab, " did more to provoke the Lord God of Israel to anger than all the kings before him,"1 Kings 16:33. So God's prophet, Elijah was sent to announce climate change - a long drought followed. 1 Kings 17:1.

Fourth, the bible foretells a time when there will be " angels to whom it will be granted to harm the earth and the sea. " Revelation 7:2 - to discipline a rebellious world.

So climate change is not new. Note (1) our misuse of earth's resources is not the main problem: (2) God uses climate change as a discipline - it highlights our dependence on Him, (3) human repentance can reverse His climate change plans.
