

It's dead certain!

The certainty of Christ's return is guaranteed in the Bible.

First, It is *a central message* of the New Testament. In 260 chapters it is mentioned 318 times.

Second, the *earliest* of the Bible's prophets foretold it - "Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied . . . saying, 'Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his saints!'" Jude 14.

Third, the Bible refers to his second coming about *eight times more often* than to his first coming.

Fourth, Jesus *himself* guarantees it. He said, "I will come again." John 14.3.

Fifth, the great apostle *Paul* continually confirms it. He speaks of Christ "at his coming" 1 Corinthians 15.23; 1 Thessalonians 2.19, etc.

Sixth, his coming will be the *ultimate* television spectacle - "They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory." Matthew 24.30.

Seventh, current history *terminates* at his return - "the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed." Daniel 2.44.

It's easy to believe in his second coming because every single prophecy of his first coming was fulfilled to the very letter.
