

Consider these firsts

Modern science expresses the universe in these five terms: time, space, matter, power and motion.

Notice how the Bible said it first: “In the beginning (*time*) God created (*power*) the heavens (*space*) and the earth (*matter*) . . . And the Spirit of God moved (*motion*) upon the face of the waters.” Genesis 1.1,2.

So the very first thing the Bible shows is God's oversight of all aspects of the universe.

Here's another Bible first: until 120 years ago sick people were “bled” and this “medical” treatment often killed them. Lose your blood, lose your life! But thousands of years ago the Bible explained blood is the *source* of life - “The life of the flesh is in the blood” Leviticus 17.11.

Eventually, in 1616, physician William Harvey discovered that blood circulation is the key factor in physical life.

Again, here is another first. In his book, *Scientific facts in the Bible*, Ray Comfort names those who *founded* and *developed* key disciplines of science - Newton, Faraday, Maxwell, Pasteur, Kepler, Galileo and many others. They were all creationists!

Centuries ago God spoke, of course, through the Bible writers. But in every age he has used godly men to honour him - including our great, modern founders of science.
