

Crash course on God

Part 3

God is infinite. “No one can measure his greatness.” Psalm 145.3 (NLT).

King Solomon said of God, “even the highest heavens cannot contain you.” 1 Kings 8.27.

First, God is so vast that even *time* cannot contain him - “he is before all things”! Colossians 1.17.

“Take a long, hard look. See how great he is - infinite, greater than anything you could ever imagine or figure out!” Job 36.26 (The Message).

Second, dare we question this vastness of God's great Person? He throws out his own challenge - “‘To whom will you compare me? Who is my equal?’ asks the Holy One.” Isaiah 40.25 (NLT).

Third, consider too his infinite humility - choosing to dwell in the unlikeliest of places - *within the confines of human hearts!*

Jesus spoke about this. He said, “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word; and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.” John 14.23. How amazing!

Fourth, all we can give to a God who has need of nothing is our admiration, our worship. Not only is it all we have to give - it's all he wants from us. In John 4.24 Jesus says exactly that.
