

# Finding God

## Part 4

How to find God?

**First**, recognise that he is personal and has revealed himself in a personal way through his prophets.

**Second**, nothing the prophets have told us has proved misleading or false. So it is through them we learn that God is a God of truth (Isaiah 65.16) – a Person we can trust.

**Third**, how serious is our need to find him? It is essential. We can see the disastrous life choices many people make when they leave God out of their lives.

**Fourth**, what is special about God? He is One who loves us. How many of us? The *whole world!* John 3.16.

**Fifth**, but does he love wicked people? Yes, even though all of us have failed to meet his requirements. None of us obey him as we should.

**Sixth**, because of our wrong-doing and disobedience towards him, God saw that we all need a rescuer, a saviour. So he sent us Jesus. He is our starting point. “There is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4.12.

That's how special Jesus is to God, so it's also how special he needs to be to us.
