

# God's great plan

Is God three Persons?

**First**, if he was only one Person, it would mean that until he created lowly creatures like us, the eternal God would be incapable of any personal interaction, incapable even of expressing love.

Does the mighty Creator indeed *depend on us* - his created beings - for companionship and love? Or is it true, instead, that within the Godhead there is fellowship and interaction, genuine relationships, love and communication taking place?

**Second**, the Bible reveals the answer. God the Son delights to obey the Holy Spirit's prompting (Mark 1.12) and willingly cooperates with the Father. John 6.38.

**Third**, it is only because incredible love resides in *all three* Persons of the Godhead that the great plan to rescue a sinful world could happen. God the Father loved us and sent his Son to be our Saviour. John 3.16.

But unless the Son shared the Father's love for us, this rescue could never have happened.

And Jesus shows us that the Holy Spirit, too, fully agrees with this great rescue plan. In speaking of the Spirit, Jesus said, "he will glorify me." John 16.14.

How wonderful that we are the target of such amazing love.
