

Did God visit us?

John's Gospel reveals Jesus as God's Son - in every chapter!

First, Jesus' supernatural knowledge of Nathaniel causes Nathaniel to say, "You are the Son of God!" John 1.49. (Only God has full knowledge of our personal lives: Psalm 139).

Second, Jesus supernaturally turns many gallons of water into wine, revealing his divinity. The result: "his disciples believed in him." John 2.11.

Third, "God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son" John 3.16. God has no other Son like the Lord Jesus. Yet he willingly gave him to die for us!

Fourth, Jesus declares he is God's Messiah (Christ). John 4.25-26. (Jesus also told Israel's high priest that he is "Christ, the Son of God". Matthew 26.63).

Fifth, Jesus declares his supernatural power to call the dead from their graves! - "the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God." John 5.25.

Sixth, Jesus leaves no doubt that he is the Son of God who has come to earth from heaven. He says emphatically: "I have come down from heaven." John 6.38.

Seventh, Jesus says, "he sent me" John 7.29. That is, God the Father sent him. So did God visit us? John, the apostle, gives a definite "yes!"
