Four notable insights

The Bible's ancient record *begins* with details of astronomy, geology, physics, biology!
Are the details accurate?

First, wherever scientists probe outer space, they find that the laws of physics are constant, well-regulated and reliable.

Many scientists see this as the work of a remarkable Creator - a unique and mighty intelligence, a single, brilliant Mind - *the very thing Genesis chapter one portrays*.

Second, the existence of billions upon billions of stars, some far greater in size than our own sun, demonstrates that whoever created all this must have boundless energy. *That too is clearly the message of Genesis chapter one*.

Third, because our scientists see Earth's environment as very good, they denounce any degradation through pollution. Again *they support the Genesis record* - "God saw everything that he had made, and indeed it was very good." Genesis 1.31.

Fourth, how many of Earth's creatures are able to recognise God? Only man. And Genesis reveals that only man was created in God's image. Genesis 1.27.

So all of the Bible's opening declarations are in full agreement with what we find in the universe and the world around us.
