The world's best brains cannot solve the problem of human sin. We are powerless to end the war in our own hearts, let alone nation warring against nation. Imagine God's horror at what we, his creatures, do to ourselves. Into such a world came Jesus, God's Son. He made himself vulnerable – the target of human aggression, hatred, insult, and eventually murder. What would God the Father do now?

What can we do to be found just before God? Nothing. We are "justified freely by his grace." Romans 3.24.
