Imagine if God said to you, “Ask for whatever you want - anything at all, nothing is too big - and I will give it to you!”

Solomon asked for wisdom and God granted his request. “King Solomon surpassed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.” 2 Chronicles 9:22.
