

## Chapter 19 The Coming One

When Jesus leaves heaven, for the second time, things will really happen.

On his first visit here, though “meek and lowly” (Matthew 11.29), he triggered events never before witnessed by man.

(3) Nations will highly honour *Jews!* (Zechariah 8.23).

(4) And see this: “All nations whom you have made shall come and worship before you,

O Lord, and shall glorify your name. For you are great, and do wondrous things; You alone are God.” Psalm 86.9-10.
